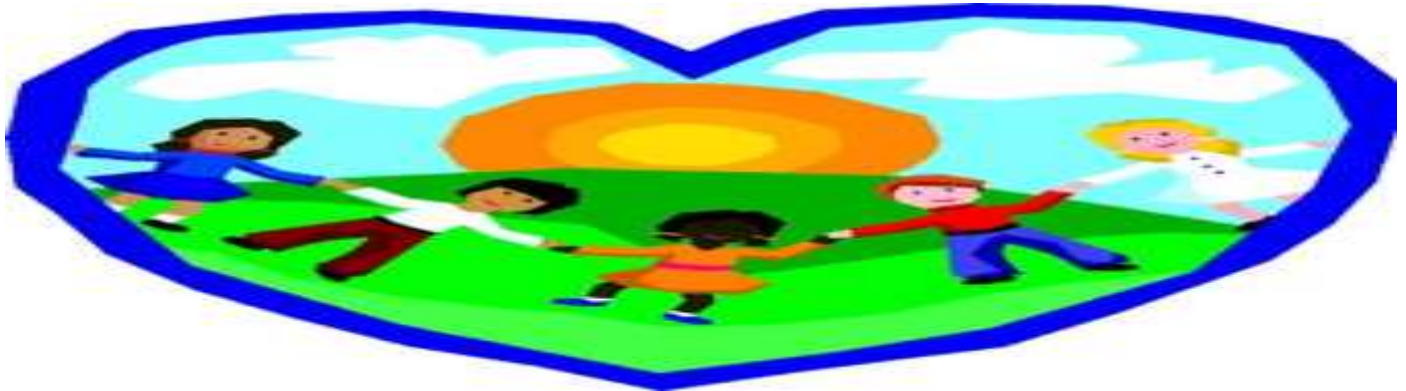


## HOLIDAYS' HOMEWORK(2017-18)
