

Kindly take care of the following things during summer vacations:-


- 1) Engage your child in conversation.
- 2) Lay emphasis on picture reading & story narration.
- 3) Encourage your ward in drawing and coloring.

Activity - I :- Take your child to the park. Tell him/her about trees, plants, flowers, grass, swings, mud, different colors , birds, sky, water etc. encourage him/her to run, jump and play on swings. Also let the child mix socially with children of his/her age group, beside elder in the park.

Activity - II :- Involve the child in small household activities to develop a sense of responsibility for e.g.

- 1) Tell him/her to handover a newspaper to grand father or a book to father etc.
- 2) Ask him/her to keep toys and belongings back in the proper place after having used or played with them.
- 3) Encourage your ward to use "Hello", "Thank You", "Excuse Me", "Welcome" and "Sorry" whenever needed.

Activity - III :- Mix two different kinds of pulses for e.g, (Rajmah and White Channa) in a bowl. Ask the child to separate the pulses in two different bowls.



F TO J: 10 Vegetables / counting (0 to 10)


K TO O: 10 Wild animals / 10 birds / 10 water animals




